Governor Brown has declared Lane County to continue to be at “extreme risk”, and so as we carefully gather on Sunday mornings only at this time, we do so adhering to the safety precautions that are outlined on the next page



As we gather to worship during this pandemic, we must continually remember that Lane County is still only in phase two of reopening and we will adhere to county health guideless. Your safety is our main priority. The following is to keep us all safe -

- If you are sick or running a fever, please stay home
- There will be no children’s church or youth group in the church building at this time
- There will be no nursery, but the cry room is available with parental supervision only
- Masks are now required indoors unless there is a medical or PTSD issue
- It is recommended that everyone sanitize their hands as they enter and exit the building
- We will adhere to social distancing, 6 feet
- Please sit next to people in your family or those who rode to church in the same car with you. There needs to be six feet separating you and anyone not meeting this criteria
- Please sit every other row in the sanctuary
- No handshaking or hugging, please
- After the service, please go immediately outside and do not congregate inside. Please socialize outside in the parking lot if it is not raining
- All other parts of the building (other than sanctuary, sanctuary foyer, and restrooms by the sanctuary) are restricted
- The church is being thoroughly cleaned and sanitized each week
- Thank you very much for your adherence and understanding during these times
