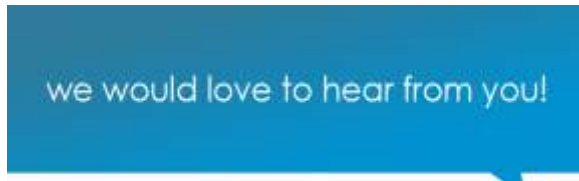
The Heart
