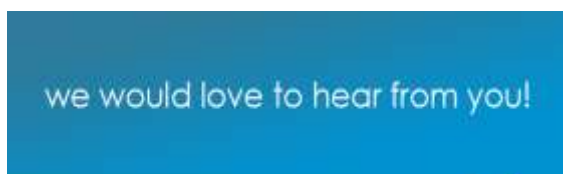
“Staying Holy During the Holidaze -

## **Fun Facts about Christmas**

The first major radio broadcast with voice and music was by Reginald Fessenden on Christmas Eve, 1906, in Brant Rock, Massachusetts. During the transmission, he played a piece of music on his violin and followed it by reading the story of the nativity from the gospel of Luke. The song he played on the violin was 'O Holy Night', making it one of the earliest, if not the first, musical pieces ever transmitted and heard over the radio. The song has been voted # 1 in The Nation's Favorite Carol on Classic FM for years
