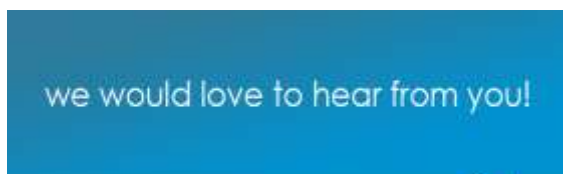


Speaker – Richard Weldon
