


I Kings 17:1-24

1 Kings begins with the story of Solomon. He was a wise king at first (1 Kings 3). Then he became rich (1 Kings 10:14-29). He built a temple (house of God) in Jerusalem (1 Kings 6). 2 Kings describes how the kings of Israel and Judah refused to obey God's law. The kings and their people did not respect God or obey His laws. Instead, they served evil gods and the behavior of the people was very wicked. However, there were a few people who truly served God. And God sent his servants (called "the prophets") to warn the people.
