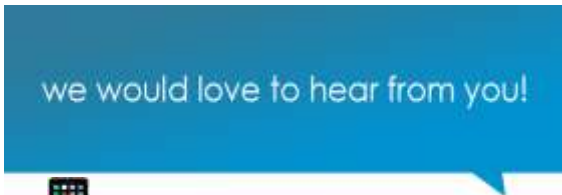
“Heart Strangely Warmed – Pentecost Fire”

Isaiah was a prophet (holy man). God appointed him to warn the people in Judah for they were evil. They needed God’s forgiveness. Isaiah described the future of many countries (Isaiah chapters 13-24). But especially, he warned his own people in Judah and Israel (Isaiah chapters 28-31). Isaiah wrote about a child who would have no human father (Isaiah 7:14). This child would become king (Isaiah 9:6). He would rule fairly (Isaiah 32). We now know that Isaiah wrote these words about Jesus.
