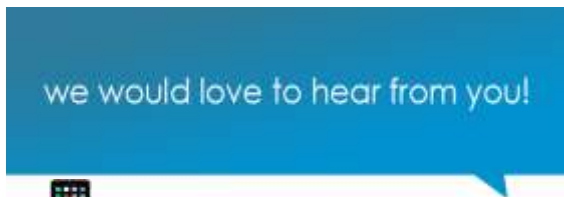
“Heart Strangely Warmed – Keep the Fire Burning”
