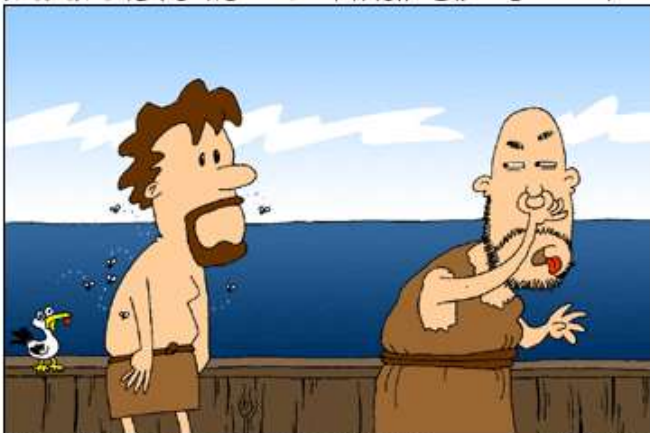

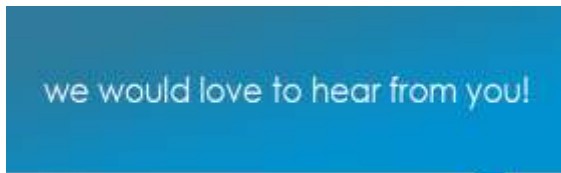
“It’s All My Money! (or is it?) – The Spirituality of
