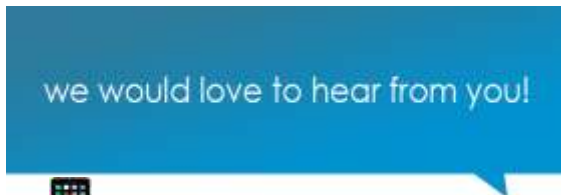
“Hunting Lions with a Squirt Gun -
